

Hello from Charlton Animal Control!

Charlton Animal Control Officers are responsible for enforcement of State and local laws and regulations related to animal control. In addition, ACOs will oversee the care and control of domestic animals and, in some instances, wildlife. The current town pound is still only suitable for impounding dogs although we are actively working towards the construction of a new pound. We respond to dog, cat, and wildlife calls and can provide numerous valuable resources appropriate for the situation.

We are seeking donations of the following supplies: dog collars (for larger dogs), leashes, and blankets. We have also created the Animal Care and Rescue Fund. This fund helps defray medical expenses incurred for sick or injured domestic animals in the care of Charlton Animal Control. Contributions to this fund will ensure that dogs, cats, and other domestic animals receive the quality veterinary care that they need, such as medications, tests, vaccinations, and procedures.
