

OPEN APPOINTMENTS FOR THE FOLLOWING: (updated 1/30/12)

BYLAW COMMITTEE - (3) MEMBERS - The Bylaw Committee is responsible for reviewing the current [Town of Charlton Bylaws](#) to update various sections as necessary.

CULTURAL COUNCIL – The goal is the cultural and artistic enrichment of our community

ENERGY COMMITTEE – (2) MEMBERS - The Mission of the Energy Committee is to promote energy conservation, energy efficiency, and explore other ways to reduce carbon emissions within the town of Charlton and in municipal affairs.

FIRE STATION BUILDING COMMITTEE: The Fire Station Building Committee will meet and discuss plans/location and provide recommendations. The following are members needed:

- One (1) person from the public involved in Building Trade
- Two (2) members of the Fire Department
- Two (2) members from the Public

HISTORICAL COMMISSION (1) MEMBER - The Charlton Historical Commission works to preserve the historic heritage of Charlton and bring to the public a greater awareness of the unique history of Charlton.

PERSONNEL BOARD – (2) MEMBERS – The Personnel Board follows the Personnel Bylaws.

PLANNING BOARD ALTERNATE – (1) MEMBER - The Planning Board is responsible for guiding and reviewing matters related to the physical growth and development of the Town of Charlton - being governed by Federal and State Statutes, local Zoning Bylaws, Subdivision Rules and Regulation. The Board also administers the Scenic Roads Act. The Master Plan is the primary guide for managing the town's growth.

WATER/SEWER COMMISSIONER - The Water/Sewer Commission is a five member committee responsible for overseeing all matters related to **public** water and sewer in the Town of Charlton.

ZONING BOARD OF APPEALS – (2) ALTERNATES - hear/decide on petitions for variances in accordance with [MGL Chapter 40A](#); To hear/decide applications for expansion of nonconforming uses in accordance with provisions of Section 3.4.3.5, application for Special Permits in accordance with Section 7.2, and Special Permits for development of flood plain zones as specified in the [Charlton Zoning Bylaws](#), Section 6.4.
