

**Charlton Public Safety Building
Capital Campaign Steering Committee
Thursday, November 12, 2020
Via Zoom**

Meeting called to order at 6:05 p.m.

Members in attendance were Steve Coleman, Monique Lemaire, Allison Jenkins, Noreen Johnson Smith, Karen Spiewak, Lois Sugrue and Finance Committee liaison John Grondalski.

Donations/pledges to date are \$167,600.00. This figure reflects a \$200,000 decrease reported in previous minutes as that pledge amount was dependent on the question passing at the ballot box in November.

Committee decided to discontinue as the Public Safety Building financing was not approved in the November 3, 2020 election. Additionally, the Committee was appointed by the Board of Selectman for only one year.

Committee voted to recommend that the Board of Selectman draft a letter to the William Francis Galvin Massachusetts Secretary of the Commonwealth, and local legislators regarding the issue with the wording on future ballot questions. The question wording is confusing and not transparent.

Steve Coleman will represent ort committee at the next Board of Selectman Meeting.

The next Capital Campaign Steering Committee will be December 10, 2020 at 6:00 pm.
